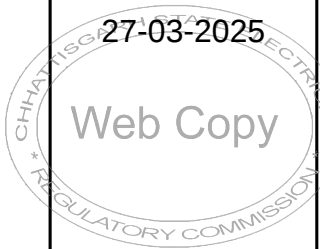

27-03-2025 	Hearing held today. Shri Rajesh Sadasivan, Superintending Engineer for respondent Chhattisgarh State Power Distribution Company Limited. 2. The Commission vide order dated 20.09.2024 passed in suo-motu petition no. 61 of 2024 enhanced the limit for maximum contract demand at LT supply voltage level from 112 kW (150 HP) to 150 kW (200 HP). 3. Chhattisgarh State Power Distribution Company Limited (CSPDCL) vide letter dated 07.03.2025 has submitted that in the tariff order issued for FY 2024-25, maximum contract demand for LT consumers is limited to 112 kW (150 HP). Therefore, tariff for LT consumers opting for contract demand of more than 112 kW (150 HP) and up to 150 kW (200 HP) has not been determined by the Commission. 4. CSPDCL submitted that after the issue of order dated 20.09.2024 passed in petition no. 61 of 2024, field units are receiving applications for LT supply with contract demand of more than 112 kW (150 HP) and upto 150 kW (200 HP), but due to non-availability of tariff for LT consumers with contract demand more than 112 kW (150 HP) upto 150 kW (200 HP), CSPDCL is facing difficulty in serving connections to such new applicants. 5. Accordingly, CSPDCL vide letter dated 07.03.2025, has requested the Commission for granting permission for billing consumers having contract demand more than 112 kW (150 HP) and upto 150 kW (200 HP) at the HV tariff of corresponding tariff category. 6. During hearing, CSPDCL has made a submission requesting the Commission for issuing an appropriate tariff for above-mentioned consumers. 7. The Commission has considered the submission of CSPDCL and found that matter is required to be disposed urgently so that pending applications for new connections may be served and appropriately billed. 8. In view of the above, it is provisionally decided that HV tariff of respective tariff category for FY 2024-25 without ToD tariff shall be applicable to contract demand more than 112 kW (150HP) and up to 150 kW (200 HP) subject to

adjustments after final order.

9. Tariff Section is directed to initiate regulatory process.
