The Commission vide its order dated 22.05.2008 has decided to grant to M/s Jindal Steel & Power Ltd. Raigarh a transmission license for the following lines.

1. 220 KV double circuit - From Jindal Steel & Power Ltd. to O.P. Jindal Industrial Park - Length - 23.07 km.
2. 220 KV double circuit - From Shri O.P. Jindal Industrial Park to Jindal Power Ltd. - Length 19.5 km.

The license shall be subject to the conditions as laid down in the provisions of the Act and the rules prescribed by the Central Government / State Government, the Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (License) Regulations, 2004, Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2004, Indian Electricity Grid Code, the Chhattisgarh State Electricity Grid Code, 2007, the relevant regulations as specified by the Central Commission and this Commission from time to time including statutory amendments and reenactment thereof. The license shall be also subject to the grant of permission by the State Government under section 68 of the Act and the relevant conditions specified therein.


Copy of the above order dated 22.05.2008 was sent to you vide letter No. 581 dated 23.05.2008.

Transmission License No. 01 of 2008

Whereas M/s. Jindal Steel & Power Ltd. (JSPL) having its Registered office at Hisar, Haryana submitted an application for a transmission license under section 15 of the Electricity Act, 2003 ('the Act' for short), which was registered as petition No. 22 of 2007(L) and was considered by the Chhattisgarh State Electricity Regulatory Commission. And whereas the Commission vide its order passed on 22.05.08 has decided to grant transmission license to the applicant for the following two transmission lines in district Raigarh State of Chhattisgarh:

- i. 220 KV double circuit JSPL-O.P. Jindal Industrial Park : 23.7 km
- ii. 220 KV double circuit OP Jindal Industrial Park-Jindal Power Ltd: 19.5 km

Now the Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 14 of the Act and in pursuance of the order aforementioned, hereby grants transmission license to the applicant for operation of two transmission lines as mentioned in above subject to the conditions as laid down in the provisions of the Act, and the rules prescribed by the Central Govt. / State Govt., the CSERC (License) Regulation, 2004 ("License Regulation" for short); CSERC (Fees & Charges) Regulation, 2004, Indian Electricity Grid Code, the State Grid Code, the relevant regulations as specified by the Central Commission and this Commission from time to time including statutory amendment and re-enactment thereof. This license is also subject to the grant of permission by the State Govt. under section 68 of the Act and the relevant conditions specified therein.

2. Commencement and term of license:

The license shall come into force from the date of issuance and shall continue to be in force for a period of 25 years, from the date of issue, as per the provision of section 15 (8) of the Act, unless revoked earlier by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of section 19 of the Act and / or CSERC (License) Regulation, 2004 (Regulation), as amended from time to time.

3. Duties and functions of the transmission licensee:

- i. The licensee shall duly discharge the duties of a transmission licensee as provided under Section 40 of the Act.
- ii. In terms of Section 17 of the Act, the licensee shall not without the prior approval of the Commission:
 - a. undertake any transaction to acquire by purchase or takeover or otherwise, the utility of any other licensee; or
 - b. acquire any beneficial interest in any generating company or generating station; or
 - c. transmit electricity to any person in the State of Chhattisgarh, not authorized by the Commission.
- iii. The licensee shall not at any time assign his license or transfer his utility, or any part thereof, by sale, lease, exchange or otherwise without the prior approval of the Commission. For obtaining such approval the licensee shall file a suitable application with the Commission disclosing relevant facts in that behalf and the Commission shall dispose of such application expeditiously.
- iv. The licensee shall duly comply with the order and directions of the National Load Despatch Centre, Regional Load Despatch Centre and the State Load Despatch Centre and other statutory authorities, issued in the discharge of their functions under the Act.

4. Transmission planning and security standards: Transmission operating standards:

- i. The licensee shall plan and operate the transmission system, so as to ensure the system is built, operated and maintained to provide an efficient, economical and co-ordinated system of transmission, in

accordance with the Grid Code and the planning, security and operating standards.

- ii. (a) The licensee shall make arrangements, within such time as the Commission may direct, to meet the power supply planning and security standards and power supply operating standards.
 - (b) The security standards are such as will ensure that the licensee conducts its planning so that transmission of electricity meets levels of reliability and quality proposed by the licensee and approved by the Commission; or as may be directed by the Commission from time to time.
 - (c) The operating standards shall be such levels of operational security as approved by the Commission from time to time.
5. The licensee shall within 3 months of the end of each financial year, submit to the Commission a report indicating the performance of the transmission system during the previous financial year. He shall, if required by the Commission, publish the report in a manner to be determined by the Commission. The copies of this report shall also be furnished by him to all persons applying for the same at the normal cost of photocopying.
6. **Connection and use of system:**
- i. The licensee shall make such arrangements for non discriminatory open access to the use of its transmission system by users subject, however, to the availability of adequate transmission capacity in accordance with open access regulation notified by the Commission.
 - ii. If, after a period which appears to the Commission to be reasonable for the purpose, the licensee fails to enter into an agreement with any intending user of the transmission system, the Commission may at the request of such intending user settle such terms of agreement and the licensee shall forthwith enter into and implement such agreement in accordance with its terms as settled by the Commission.
7. **Revenue calculation and tariffs:**
- i. The licensee shall calculate the expected revenue from charges which it is permitted to recover, in accordance with the provisions of the Act,

the license regulations, the tariff terms and conditions and other guidelines, orders and directions issued by the Commission from time to time.

- ii. The licensee shall file the expected revenue calculation and the application containing tariff proposals in the manner provided in the CSERC (Conduct of Business) Regulation 2004 and consistent with the regulations notified by the Commission under Section 61 of the Act.

8. Information to the Commission:

The licensee shall furnish to the Commission without undue delay such information, documents and details related to the licensed business or any other business of the licensee, as the Commission may require from time to time for its own purposes or for the purpose of the Government of India, State Government, the Central Commission and / or the Central Electricity Authority, the State Transmission Utility and the State Load Despatch Centre.

9. Compliance with laws, rules and regulations:

- i. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Act, and the License Regulations, orders and directions issued by the Commission from time to time.
- ii. The licensee shall act in accordance with the general conditions notified in the License Regulations except where he is exempted from any of the provisions of the general conditions at the time of the grant of licence or otherwise specifically obtains the approval of the Commission for any deviations there from.

10. Contravention of terms and conditions of licence:

If there is a contravention or likelihood of a contravention of the terms and conditions of licence, by the licensee the Commission may pass such orders as it thinks fit in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

11. Terms of revocation:

Subject to the provisions of Section 19 of the Act and the regulations framed thereunder, the Commission may, at any time initiate proceedings against a licensee for revocation of licence. If the Commission is satisfied that there are grounds for revocation, it may revoke the licence in the public interest.

12. Provisions relating to safety:

The licensee shall comply with such measures relating to transmission of electricity as per the provisions of section 53 of the Act.

13. Dispute resolution:

- i. The Commission shall be entitled to act as arbitrator or nominate person(s) as arbitrator(s) to adjudicate and settle disputes between a licensee and any other licensee(s) or between the licensee and a generating company in pursuance of clause (f) of Sub-Section(1) of Section 86 read with Section 158 of the Act and the regulations of the Commission.
- ii. The arbitration proceedings for disputes as above may be commenced and conducted by the Commission or the disputes may be referred to the arbitration of others, as the case may be, in accordance with the CSERC (Conduct of Business) Regulation, 2004.

14. License fees:

During the period that the license is in force, the licensee shall make payment of license fees in accordance with the CSERC (Fees and Charges) Regulation, 2004.

15. Interpretation

All issues relating to interpretation of this licence and its terms and conditions, shall be a matter for determination by the Commission and the decisions of the Commission on such issues shall be final, subject only to the right of appeal.

- 16.** The conditions of this license may be altered or amended by the Commission at any time, if it deems fit in the public interest, in terms of Section 18 of the Act.
