This case was listed for preliminary hearing today for the compliance of the directions in order dated 06.05.2026. The counsels for the Petitioner furnished their Vakalatnama today along with Power of Attorney. 3. The counsels for the Petitioner made their preliminary arguments submitting that the petitioner has complied with the direction in order dated 06.05.2026 in concurrence with their submission dated 15.06.2026. The counsel for the Petitioner has also submitted a note for proposal for acquisition of land and other assets in the proposed license area in an around Raipur on behalf of the petitioner. It is submitted that they have duly complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements in terms of Regulation 7 of the CSERC (License) Regulations, 2004. 4. It is observed that the submissions dated 15.06.2026 and note for proposal for acquisition of land made on behalf of Petitioners are not accompanied with a notarized affidavit and therefore, cannot be taken up on record. The petitioner is directed to submit both the documents afresh accompanied with affidavit duly notarized. The petitioner is also directed that any and all submissions being made on behalf of the petitioner shall be made on notarized affidavit. 5. We find that the application made by petitioner is complete in all respects as per the Electricity Act, 2003 and CSERC (License) Regulations, 2004 with regards to application for grant of distribution license. Hence, the petition be registered now. 6. It is further directed to submit the draft of public notice as prescribed in FORM-4 in terms of Regulation 8 of the CSERC (Licenses) Regulations, 2004 for the approval of the Commission. Also, the petitioner is required to comply the provisions specified in Regulation 9(1) of the license Regulations. 7. Furthermore, the petitioner is also directed to obtain "No Objection" Certificate from the Central Government establishments in terms of clause (ii) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 15 of the Electricity Act, 2003, prior to placing application for hearing to the Commission. 8.
