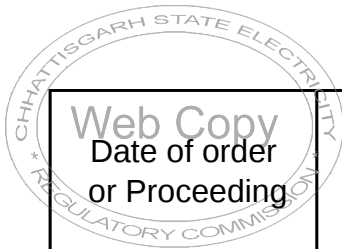

3. Shri Hemant Singh, made detailed submissions regarding interpretation of regulations and order dated 23.12.2025 in petition no 51 of 2025 and draft order dated 23.01.2026 in this petition.
4. Shri Arun Poddar submitted that they had drawn green power from Indian Energy Exchange (IEX) for short duration not the whole month whereas the clarificatory order dated 23.12.2025 in petition no 51 of 2025 does not address the issues arising due to such transactions.
5. Shri Abhinav Karderkar submitted copy of multi-source consumers wise calculation sheets as per formula prescribed in draft order dated 23.01.2026 in this petition and 23.12.2025 in petition no 51 of 2025 along with summary of calculation provided by CSPDCL accompanied by covering memo.
6. The Commission will initiate separate proceeding for MSC's who availed very short duration/intermittent power in a month.
7. The Commission further directed the respondent SLDC to submit UI billing with respect to M/s Jindal Steel Power Ltd. within one week.
8. The case is closed for order.
