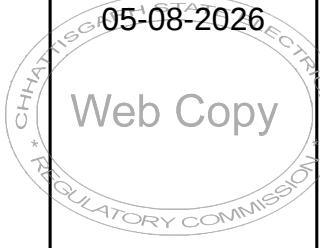

During the course of the argument the petitioner submitted that they are confining the relief sought to the installation of prepaid meters as the 2nd prayer regarding advance payment may face practical implementation challenges on account of economic un viability, whereas, upon the questioning the respondent CSPDCL with regards to the advance payment and the discount provided there in the respondent CSPDCL submits that the same may require development of standard operating procedures. 4. It was also pointed out by the Commission that as per the clause 4.55 (a)(iv) of the Chhattisgarh State Electricity Supply Code (4th amendment) 2024 the respondent CSPDCL was directed to submits SoP to the Commission within one month of the notification of the code. Whereas, the CSPDCL has failed to do so. The Commission raised another question as to why HT- meters were not covered under the implementation of the Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme (RDSS)?. 5.
