**2.** The petitioner CSPDCL has approached for clarification of order dated 03.03.2026, wherein, the Commission extended the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) dated 04.11.2006 as transferred to the respondent through the supplementary PPA dated 26.09.2023 for a further period of nine (09) years beyond its expiry date of 04.11.2026.

**3.** It is pertinent to note that, generally the PPA is executed prior to the date of Commercial Operation (COD) of any power plant. However, as agreed by the parties that the PPA dated 04.11.2006 was executed after achieving COD.

**4.** It is also, necessary to note that, in the principle PPA dated 04.11.2006 under article-2 it is mentioned that-

*"02. This Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) will remain in force for a period of 3 [three] years from the date of its signing **during which the company shall start commercial operation** failing which the PPA will be deemed as cancelled without any liability on either party. After commercial operation of power plant, the PPA shall remain in*

*force up to financial year 2014-15 for the purchase or sale of power to the Board.”*

In the instant case, the petitioner CSPDCL has failed to place on record any document or evidence that would establish the actual date of commercial operation of said Biomass Based Power Plant. The Commission has passed the order dated 03.03.2026 based on the prayers of the original petition no. 65 of 2025, in which the petitioner has prayed for extension of PPA dated 04.11.2006.

**5.** In view of the above, the Commission finds that the order dated 03.03.2026 is sufficiently clear in its intent and therefore, no further clarification is required.

**6.** The petition is dismissed.”
